

FIVE PETAL FLOWER

Design by Denice Johnson, inspired by a knit flower by Isela Phelps. This is the perfect project for all those extra balls of yarn you have laying around.



Knitting loom: 12 peg flower loom

Yarn: 50 yards of 4 medium weight in red heart super saver in white or any color

Notions: knitting tool, tapestry needle

Gauge: 4 stitches and 6 rows to 1 inch

Abbreviations

K=knit stitch

Pattern note: use one strand throughout entire project, pattern is worked in the round

INSTRUCTIONS

Petal:

Draw string cast on all 12 pegs, work in the round.

Rounds 1-10: knit to the end of round.

Remove with basic bind off. Sew closed, give a little tug to set stitches.

Make 4 more Petals as instructed above.

FINISHING

Line up all 5 pieces side by side on a flat surface, on flat edge fold over so corner touch and place on needle. Repeat for remainder of petals. Run through the first petal again and pull tight. Turn over and sew the back in place, turn over to front side and add a accent button.
